

Marion Davies' Beverly Hills Mansion Sold For \$9.3 Million

The Beverly Hills mansion once owned by renowned actress [Marion Davies](#) has just sold to a real estate professional for \$9.3 million.

The Huffington Post Los Angeles [wrote about the house](#) when it was first listed for \$12.5 million in September of last year.

The 6,000 square-foot Old Hollywood stunner was built in 1923, and was apparently purchased for the starlet by her boyfriend, mogul [William Randolph Hearst](#). It was Davies' first home in Los Angeles, reports [Deco Films](#).

The property was later owned by producer Harry Cohn and then writer Aleen Leslie. Celebrities such as Charlie Chaplin and Rudolph Valentino have visited the property for Davies' decadent parties.
